WHAT WE DO

Family Support Specialists:

- Help families navigate the special education process (e.g., transitions, special education forms)
- Relay and explain federal and state special education laws (e.g., special education timelines, parents' rights)
- Provide resources in areas of special education
- Inform families of research-based strategies, best practices, and supports in special education

- Present information to families and community groups and provide professional development to educational staff
- Work on various initiatives, like Family Engagement, to improve the educational partnership among families, schools, and communities
- Participate in school and community resource fairs and events
- Connect families with organizations that support families and youth with special education and health concerns
- Help support the FAMILIES TO THE MAX Pennsylvania Statewide Family Network
- Lend a family perspective to the training and technical assistance provided to local educational agencies (LEAs) by PaTTAN consultants
